Join the Teen Comics Club!

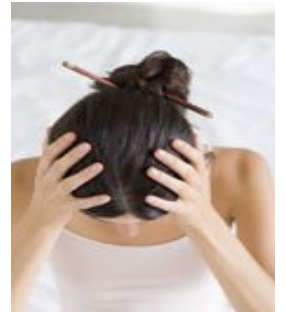
Do you like Manga, Anime, Comics or Graphic Novels?
